Each Level Expands the Knowledge of the Previous

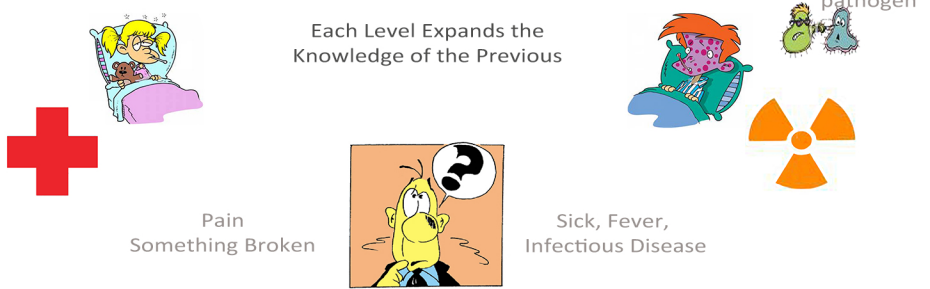
People usually enter the Healthcare System for two reasons – either they have something broken in their body or they have picked-up a pathogen or other foreign agent and are sick.

How and where they enter the Healthcare System is the largest contributing factor associated with not only their well being and the ultimate cost to resolve the issue, but also the well being of others who come in contact with them.

The most expensive and deadly place to treat a patient is in the special intensive care areas of a hospital. The least expensive and safest is inside one's own home.

The current concept of designing healthcare systems that brings patients with something broken to a place where they have more than a 25% chance of becoming in contact with an infectious pathogen is wrong. This is how my father lost his life. He entered the health care system for something broken, in his case a hip, acquired pneumonia while at the hospital, and never made it out.

The Healthcare Kosmos is a system designed to identify what type of problem a patient is experiencing and then following a path that constantly treats the patient at the most isolated and least expensive level of treatment.

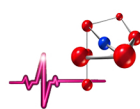
